

Every year, for many years now, I've helped 3-10 of our students find internships at, among other places, the following:

1. The campaign office of Congressman Adam Schiff.
2. The campaign office of Congressman David Dreier.
3. The campaign office of Assembly challenger and former SMHS graduate Susan Carpenter McMillan,
4. The campaign office of at least 5-10 other challenges for either an Assembly and/or Senate seat.
5. The campaign office of then Assembly Member Carol Liu.
6. The campaign office of Assembly member Mike Eng
7. The campaign office of Assembly member Ed Chau

I have also helped students find internship opportunities in a good dozen or so different law offices. (SMHS attorney Wendy Do, for example, has had at least two of my students work for her over the years.)

I've also helped our students find an internship at the Los Angeles District attorney's office (we'll have one there this summer, thanks to Marian Thompson)

I've also helped our students to find interships at City Hall (This summer two of our students will be interning at City Hall, thanks to City Manager John Schaefer. Last year we also had a student intern at City Hall, again thanks to the City Manager.

On occasion over the years, I've also been given permission by the Constitutional Rights Foundation to permit one or more of our students to apply for CRF's Expanding Horizon's Internship Program - though normally EHI is looking for students who meet the following criteria:

- * Neither parent has a college degree from a four-year institution
- * Be eligible to for the free/reduced meals program at their school

This year I also arranged for Matthew Dietzel to intern for Marshall Tuck (running against Tom Torlakson for state superintendent.).

I've even helped former students find internships (just this past year in fact, I helped Royce Stutteville get an internship with the Constitutional Rights Foundation.
