DESCRIPTIONS

ART EDUCATION: Volunteers support by assisting before, during, and after art lessons in order to provide high quality art instruction for your child. No art experience is necessary.

ART FESTIVAL: During the two weeks before the Art Festival, volunteers help file, organize, mount, and display children's art projects under the guidance of Art Fair Chairs. Help is needed taking down the exhibit and delivering the artwork to each class.

BIKE RODEO: All 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade children may participate in the Bike Rodeo administered by the Safety Committee and the San Marino Fire Department. Volunteers set up and supervise the written and riding tests that the children must pass to receive permission to ride their bikes to school.

BOOK FAIR: Help is needed setting up, taking down, and/or working a shift or more during the week of the fair. Through the sale of books and educational materials, this fair helps raise funds and expand the classrooms' and Library's book collections.

CARVER CARNIVAL: The second biggest fundraiser of the year, this popular event needs volunteers to help organize the various booths and activities. Great for working parents.

CARVER HELPERS ON CALL [CHOC]: An on call group of volunteers, who can give an hour or two during the month to help copy, collate, stuff envelopes or do other special PTA projects as needed (data entry). Perfect for working parents and those with small children.

COMPUTER LAB: Our children receive hands-on computer training in accordance with a district-wide master plan. Volunteers are needed year round to assist when classes are in the computer lab. Training will be provided.

CURRICULUM LAB: Located at the San Marino USD site, volunteers who can commit to one or more Wednesday mornings each month will cut and paste educational materials for the classrooms. No experience is necessary.

GIFT ITEMS & COOKIE DOUGH FUNDRAISER: Help needed for tallying orders and distributing goodies upon delivery.

LIBRARY VOLUNTEERS: Parent volunteers assist the librarians in the routines necessary for the running of the Carver School Library. No library experience is necessary. An orientation and regular schedule will be provided. With the help of volunteers, the library is open every day and utilized and enjoyed by all grade levels, including after school. (**Note:** The *Read Aloud Program* is a separate program with sign up sheets available through your child's classroom and the Library.)

LUNAR NEW YEAR CELEBRATION: An all grade level celebration. Volunteers are needed to help serve food, work with the children at the various arts and crafts booths, as well as help decorate and set up.

MUSIC BOX: This engaging music enrichment program allows students to check out music bags with information and guides on various musicians with new ones added yearly. Help is needed with check-in, check-out and re-stocking.

PARENT PARTY: This main fundraiser of the year requires many volunteers for its multifaceted activities: advertising, sales, decorating, planning, printing, cashiering, writing, copying, etc.

READING INCENTIVE PROGRAM: Help is needed with collecting forms, tallying and prize distribution.

SAFETY: Assist with drop-off and/or pick-up.

SCIENCE FAIR: This fair exhibits all of our participating students' science projects. Help is needed setting up and taking down the exhibits, guiding classroom tours before the Science Fair or visitors the night of. No science background is required.

SUBSTITUTING FOR TEACHERS DURING PARENT/TEACHER LUNCHEONS: Volunteers are needed to stay with the teachers' classes while the teachers are at their parent teacher luncheons. No teaching experience is necessary; activities for the kids will be prepared by the teachers ahead of time.

TRANSLATION FOR PTA/SCHOOL FUNCTIONS: Bilingual volunteers needed to provide translation of select PTA and school functions/documents/information for non-English speaking parents.

YEARBOOK: Help is needed taking and collecting pictures of school events as well as administration and production of yearbook.
