RESOLUTION #
A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SAN MARINO UNIFIED
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, REGARDING
SUFFICIENCY OF TEXTBOOKS OR INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS**

Whereas, the Governing Board of the San Marino Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of *Education Code* Section 60119 held a public hearing on Tuesday, September 27, 2016, at seven thirty, which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

Whereas, the Governing Board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

Whereas, the Governing Board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders (if the district or county office has a bargaining unit) in the public hearing, and;

Whereas, information provided at the public hearing and to the Governing Board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners and other students with special needs;

Whereas, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials; and

Whereas, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials are provided to each student, including English learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board in the following subjects: English language arts, history-social science, mathematics, science, health and foreign language.

Whereas, adequate laboratory science equipment and sufficient materials are available for science laboratory classes offered in grades K-12, inclusive;

Therefore, it is resolved that for the 2016-2017 school year, the San Marino Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials.
